Reading

- Read with your child, daily if possible, and comment in their reading record.
- * This time could include activities to support the reading such as drawing a picture about the book or talking about what might happen next.
- Me It could be a book from the library, non-fiction book or comic - 'all reading is good reading'.

Maths or English Homework

- This should take half an hour maximum per week.
- * Feel free to comment on whether your child needed support or anything else you think we would like to know.
- * Please ensure they complete it as independently as possible and it is presented neatly in a writing pencil.
- Encourage your child to use the sounds they know in any writing.

Spellings

- # Help your child to practise their spellings regularly over the week.
- * They will be tested on Tuesday and will receive a certificate for doing well.

- @ Complete the homework activity set each week.
- * Feel free to allow your child to access the site at any other time to try other activities.

Homework books are given out on a Wednesday. Spelling books will also be sent home on Wednesday so you can see how your child did in their spelling test.
