Dear Parents and Carers

On Monday, we will be having a Superhero day in school to support a pupil who attended our Nursery. Marcus was diagnosed with cancer at the age of 2 and continues his battle against the disease.

His current school Barley fields are arranging to raise funds to support Marcus and his family. Please see the letter below from Mrs Taylor.

Marcus is a pupil in Year 3 and was diagnosed with a brain tumour at the age of 2. In that time Marcus has endured scans, a biopsy and chemotherapy which made him incredibly poorly but throughout it all he remains a happy, confident and delightful member of our school who is rarely absent and is loved by all who know him. It has been agreed that Proton Therapy in America is the next best option for him. In total, £11,000 is needed to send the family to the States. This money isn't for his Proton Therapy (this will be NHS funded as it isn't available in this country) but will be used to support Marcus and his family in America, to allow them to decamp for 10 weeks so they can be at his side during the vital treatment.



The Friends of Barley Fields, along with the school, would love to invite you to support Marcus and his family with their fundraising by taking part in this day.

Lots of local schools have agreed to help and so on **Monday 22nd January** we will be having a **Superhero Day**. Children are invited to come into their school dressed in superhero clothing and make a donation to Marcus' fund.

All funds raised will be forward to Marcus' fund by the Friends of Barley Fields.
