<p><b>Objective</b> Constructs and creates with a purpose in mind using a variety of resources. (by 48 months) Uses simple tools and techniques competently and appropriately. (by 54 months) Selects appropriate resources and adapts work where necessary. (by 60 months)</p> <p><b>Direct Teaching Activity</b> ER (KS supporting): Look at one of Van Gogh's self-portraits. Discuss who it is, what he did, where he lived, when he lived, his style of painting.</p> <p><b>Group Work/Continuous Provision</b> ER - In areas modelling expectations and learning opportunities - open ended role play</p> <p>KS - Self-portraits in the style of Van Gogh (paint)</p>	<p><b>Objective</b> Constructs and creates with a purpose in mind using a variety of resources. (by 48 months) Uses simple tools and techniques competently and appropriately. (by 54 months) Selects appropriate resources and adapts work where necessary. (by 60 months)</p> <p><b>Direct Teaching Activity</b> ER (KS supporting): Review learning on Van Gogh. Look at his picture of Sunflowers and talk about style. Model re-creating.</p> <p><b>Group Work/Continuous Provision</b> KS - In areas modelling expectations and learning opportunities - book corner</p> <p>ER - Flowers in the style of Van Gogh (pastels)</p> <p>Baking group 5: ER to support initially, monitor and assess. Also in areas modelling expectations and learning opportunities.</p>	<p><b>Objective</b> Uses talk to retell events and simple stories, ask questions. (by 54 months) Uses talk correctly to organise, sequence and clarify thinking, ideas, feelings and events. (by 60 months)</p> <p><b>Direct Teaching Activity</b> ER (Supported by KS): Look at Starry Night and discuss. Model answering questions. Where is this? What do you think it's like there? Would you like to go there? Why/why not? It was one of Van Gogh's favourite place - where is your favourite place?</p> <p><b>Group Work/Continuous Provision</b> ER - In areas modelling expectations and learning opportunities - open ended role play</p> <p>KS - Experiencing Art Style Sheet - Starry Night. Answers questions and drawing a picture.</p> <p>Technology - Swirl Art project on Purple Mash.</p>	<p><b>Objective</b> Constructs and creates with a purpose in mind using a variety of resources. (by 60 months)</p> <p><b>Direct Teaching Activity</b> KH (KS supporting): Look at the picture of Van Gogh's bedroom. Talk about the depth he created. Can you draw a picture of your bedroom in the same style? Model doing mine.</p> <p><b>Group Work/Continuous Provision</b> KS - In areas modelling expectations and learning opportunities - book corner</p> <p>KH - Children drawing pictures of their bedroom in the style of Van Gogh (coloured pencils)</p>	<p><b>Objective</b> Constructs and creates with a purpose in mind using a variety of resources. (by 48 months) Uses simple tools and techniques competently and appropriately. (by 54 months) Selects appropriate resources and adapts work where necessary. (by 60 months)</p> <p><b>Direct Teaching Activity</b> KH (KS supporting): Comparing Van Gogh to Henri Matisse. Both French Artists but different styles. Compare different pictures by displaying at the same time by printing out and sticking on the board (in resources file)</p> <p><b>Group Work/Continuous Provision</b> KH - In areas modelling expectations and learning opportunities - book corner</p> <p>KS - Use a canvas (cut ER card) to create a picture thinking of what you've learnt this week - depth, colour, style, context). Provide different resources - paint, felt tips, crayons, coloured pencils, pastels.</p>
