






## *Basic Homework Expectations for Year 4*






### *Reading*



 Children should be reading at least 5 times a week. They should;

-  read independently 3 times per week
-  be supported by an adult at least twice a week. One of these should be as directed by the teacher from Guided Reading in class. Notes should be written in reading records please.


### *Maths or English Homework*

-  Activities should be completed to a high standard.
-  Presentation, handwriting, punctuation and spellings should be of the same high standard that is expected in class work.
-  Feel free to comment on whether your child needed support or anything else you think we would like to know.

### *Spellings*

-  Spellings should be learned so they can be recalled in written work.
-  Rules should also be learned where appropriate so they can be applied in all areas of work.

### *Times Tables*

-  These should be practised until instant recall is achieved.

*All homework should be completed on time and handed in for marking.*
