<p>Objective Circle Time - taking turns and accepting the needs of others.</p> <p>I am learning to take turns. I am learning that other children have needs too.</p> <p>Direct Teaching Activity ER (KS supporting): Talk about taking turns and how it is important that we all get a turn. Watch Youtube video - Sesame Stree Two Headed Monster takes turns. Model playing a game- talk about how we have to wait for our turn to come round.</p> <p>Group Work/Continuous Provision</p> <p>KS - Play games and model taking turns and being patient.</p> <p>ER - In areas modelling expectations and learning opportunities</p>	<p>Objective I am learning to follow instructions independently. I am learning to talk about changes I observe.</p> <p>Begin independent baking starting with cupcakes -using picture recipe card. Ask children to talk about/record changes they observe</p> <p>Direct Teaching Activity ER (KS supporting): Talk about independent baking and that each group will get a turn. Come up with some rules- listen to each other, wash our hands, do not put anything in our mouth etc.</p> <p>Group Work/Continuous Provision Baking group 1- KS to support to begin with as it's the first time weighing etc.</p> <p>ER - In areas modelling expectations and learning opportunities</p>	<p>Objective Painting - pictures of animals Adding details to their representations</p> <p>I am learning to paint a picture and add detail.</p> <p>Direct Teaching Activity ER (Supported by KS): Model drawing a picture of your favourite animal- show how we take our time and add details to our representation.</p> <p>Group Work/Continuous Provision ER - Children to paint a picture of their favourite animal- print some examples for them to use. Once dry they can add details using black felt tips.</p> <p>KS - In areas modelling expectations and learning opportunities including the vets role play area.</p>	<p>Objective 'My Family' Who lives in your house?</p> <p>Direct Teaching Activity ER (KS supporting): Talking about special events in current family life.</p> <p>Group Work/Continuous Provision KH - In areas modelling expectations and learning opportunities Outdoor Area</p>  <p>KS - Continue making pictures of my family using the lollipop sticks.</p>	<p>Objective Uses talk to retell events and simple stories.</p> <p>I am learning to retell simple stories.</p> <p>Direct Teaching Activity EL (KS supporting): Split into two groups and read a simple story. Each group has to talk about their story and share what happened with the other group.</p> <p>Group Work/Continuous Provision</p> <p>KS - In areas modelling expectations and learning opportunities Mark Making with cars and pens</p> <p>Golden time (Red group) - talk about expectations during circle time- listening, only speaking when it is your turn, do not touch anybody else's objects, asking interesting questions.</p>
