Dear Parents/Carers

I am writing today with updates on the works for the leisure centre. We have just been informed this will start on Monday 5th February. Timelines and impact are as follows:

Timeline	Action	Impact
WB 5 th February 2018 – WB 12 th Feb 2018	Service diversion (gas, electricity etc.) works will begin. This is focused on the grass mound at the front of school. (This area will become the leisure centre and All saints car park)	Partial footpath closure – from All Saints entrance to Myton Park School entrance. Pupils who cross at the lights by the roundabout, will be able to walk in front of All Saints and the Library to access Myton Park.
WB 12 Feb until End of June 2019	Full length of the footpath from the top of Blair Avenue (Tesco end) to the car park entrance of Myton Park will be fully closed.	A temporary set of traffic lights will be established to the west, in between the exit to Myton Park Car Park and the Care Home.
April 2018 – end of May 2018	Relocation of service yard road, building of new All Saints and leisure centre car park.	Fencing around the whole area. Additional caution required due to heavier plant traffic.
June 2018 – September/October 2019	Building of the new leisure centre.	New car park ready and used by All Saints and Library. Whole building are will be fully cordoned off.

We are awaiting final documentation from the local authority. Once this has arrived in school we will create a new tab on our website for the duration of the works to include all information we receive.

We are working with some organisations to ensure that we provide some specific road safety training for ALL children at Myton Park to help them understand the additional need for care with heavy plant traffic. We anticipate this will happen in June.

May we take this opportunity to remind you that this is all being coordinated and organised by Stockton Borough Council and any queries about the project should be directed towards them.
