The children will all come home today with a reading record – either their reception one or a new one if they didn't have one today or their reception one was full. If they come home with a new reading record and you still have their reception one at home feel free to keep this or return it to school.

The children are currently being assessed to see which level of Read Write Inc will be appropriate for their learning currently and groups for Read Write Inc teaching should start next week.

The children will start to bring home school reading books. Please read with your child regularly – each night if possible – and sign their reading record. You can write a comment about a particular skill you focussed on, they managed well or needed support with if you wish.

The children might bring home:

– a free choice book (selected by them from a box with a coloured sticker and white sticker on the spine)

– a 'Favourite Five' Book (one of 5 books we will focus on each half term in our classroom)

– a RWI book (a book to support their phonic knowledge development)

The books will be quarantined for 48 hours when they are returned to school before they go back in to circulation for the children to choose from.

The children will begin to work in small groups to take part in guided reading sessions within our health and safety guidelines so will be reading additional books each week with a member of staff at school.

Any questions about reading or reading books please let us know. This is a slight change from our normal reading routine to keep everyone as safe as possible so let us know if anything comes up which is not working.
