Dear Parents/Carers,

As a part of your child's education at Myton Park Primary School, we promote personal wellbeing and development through a comprehensive Personal, Social, Health and Economic (PSHE) education programme. PSHE education is the curriculum subject that gives children the knowledge, understanding, attitudes and practical skills to live safe, healthy, productive lives and meet their full potential.

I am writing to let you know that, over the next 5 weeks, starting Monday 14th June, your child's class will be taking part in lessons which will focus on the relationships and sex education (RSE) aspect of this programme.

Lessons in year 5 and 6 will include pupils learning about growing and changing, including puberty; personal hygiene; and changing feelings. Pupils will also have opportunities to ask questions.

Parents do not have the right to withdraw their children from relationship education but do have the right to withdraw their children from the non-statutory components of sex education within RSE. At Myton Park Primary School this term, we will not be teaching anything beyond statutory guidance. Any requests for withdrawal should be put in writing and addressed to the Head Teacher.

PSHE education is taught throughout the school in every year group and is monitored and reviewed regularly by the staff and governing body. All PSHE teaching takes place in a safe learning environment and is underpinned by our school ethos and values.
