First or third person. Adjectives and adverbs. Adjectives and expanded noun phrases. Suffixes (-ing -ed, -er, -est, -ful -ness). Suffix 'ly' with root words ending in 'le' or 'ic' Apostrophes for contractions. Rare GPCs 'l' sound.
