



## Newsletter Summer 2 2022

We are reaching the conclusion of another school year – what a year it has been. We have had an amazing term returning to a full programme of events such as the Summer Fayre, Sports Day, Platinum Jubilee, school visits and after school clubs. The struggles from earlier in the year with significant staff and pupil absence due to Covid seems a distant memory.

### Covid

We have had a small number of Covid cases in school, government guidance remains the same. Anyone with a positive Covid test is advised to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for five days, which is when they are most infectious. **For children and young people aged 18 and under this is for three days.** Children who are unwell and have a high temperature are advised to stay at home and avoid contact with other people. Children can return to school when they no longer have a high temperature, and they are well enough to attend.

### Timings of the School Day

As previously shared with you, from September to ensure we meet the 32.5 hours of weekly

schooling, registration will commence at 8:50am, anyone arriving after this time will be marked late. To support a fluid entry to school, doors will open at 8:40am.

### Events in School

We have loved every minute of this term, sharing events with you all. From the Platinum Jubilee, to the Summer Fayre and finally Sports Day. Across all three events we have raised £1375.33 for our PTA funds, an amazing achievement – thank you.



All years groups have been on an educational visit this term. Year 4 children also experienced a night away camping with Bush Craft. Wherever we have been, I always receive the same message that our children are polite, courteous and a credit to school. We are very proud of all of our children and wanted to share this with you.

### **Wrap Around Care: Mrs B's Community Hive**

Following our parent survey and speaking with parents on the yard, before and afterschool child care provision was something you would like to see at Myton Park. Logistically we can not provide this ourselves on site.

The cost of this service is:

- Breakfast Club: £6.50 plus £1.50 drop off charge – this includes breakfast.
- Afterschool Club: £12.00 plus £1.50 pick up charge – this includes a light snack.

(If you require pick up and drop off 5 days per week please contact Mrs B to discuss this

charge.) It is important to note for Mrs B to operate this service, there needs to be a minimum of 8 children each morning and afterschool.

### **Earrings**

If you are considering getting your child's ears pierced, we do ask that this is done at the start of the summer holidays, to allow maximum healing time. In line with safety requirements earrings do need to be removed for all PE sessions. Where it is less than 6 weeks since piercing or where there are exceptional circumstances earrings can be taped. Taping must be secure and in place prior to school, as staff will not apply taping. If you feel there is an exceptional circumstance please come into school to discuss this, the final decision will remain with school.
