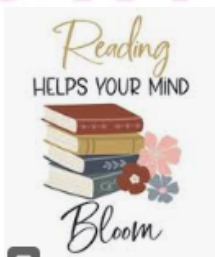


Other news:

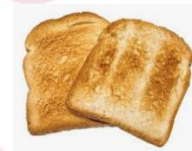

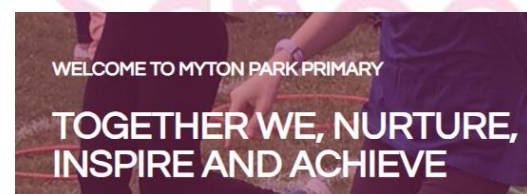
