Our Scholastic Book Fair will also be in school on this day. Children will visit the fair during the school day and bring home a wish list. Please highlight the books you have purchased and return the wish list to school once payment is complete. Payments can be made online and should be completed by Monday 9th March. Your child's £1 book token can be used towards the Scholastic Book Fair.

Bookshelf Bookmark Competition – £5 Book Voucher

As part of our commitment to encouraging a love of reading and celebrating the National Year of Reading, all pupils will receive a folding *Bookshelf Bookmark* to take home.

Children are invited to design the front and back of the bookmark. Inside, there is a bookshelf where pupils can record books they read throughout the rest of the school year. These bookmarks will be used to support reading discussions with teachers and peers.

We encourage children to record all types of reading from both home and school — including fiction, non-fiction, graphic novels, magazines and comics — as we want children to know that all reading is valuable.

The winning design from each class will receive a £5 book voucher to spend at the Scholastic Book Fair.
